



Dr. Ali Khodaii

Ali Khodaii is presently a Professor at the School of Civil Engineering, AmirKabir University of Technology, Tehran. He obtained his BSc in Civil Engineering from Bradford University in 1979 and continued his Master degree in the same university and graduated in 1980. Later he attended the Queens University for his PhD and graduated in 1984.

Having completed his PhD, he was appointed initially as an assistant professor and later worked his way up the academia to full professorship during the following years. His research is concentrated on Transportation subjects both in planning and policy making but more recently on asphalt mix properties and in particular incorporating waste materials in asphalt mixtures with environmental concerns in mind.

He has successfully supervised more than 50 PhD and MSc students. He has published more than 100 papers in indexed international journals and many more in proceedings and local journals, with a total citation of more than 3300 and an h-index of 31, based on Scopus.
